

## Dust filters compliant according to EC 1935:2004


When supplying filtration articles, we ensure to comply with the required level of documentation and our foodstuff approved items are supplied in accordance to EC 1935:2004, EC 2023:2006 and (EU) No. 10/2011.

Nordic Air Filtration fulfills the European requirements for manufacturing of air filters for the food industry according to the following standards: **Regulation (EC) No. 1935/2004** - on materials and articles intended to come into contact with food.

**Regulation (EC) No.10/2011** - on substances and plastic materials permitted in manufacture of Food Contact Materials that are intended to come in contact with food.

**Regulation (EC) No. 2023/2006** - on Good Manufacturing Practice (GMP) which applies to all food contact materials and all stages of manufacture, processing and distribution of materials and articles, up to but excluding the production of starting substances.

All the food producers situated in countries that are members of the EU must follow the regulations of EC 1935:2004 – regardless on whether the equipment or solutions are supplied from countries within or outside the EU.
